Dear Parents,

PDS is encouraging each student to read during the summer. Reading-- even just a few minutes each day -- will help sustain and improve your child's reading skills. You received information about the two books that your student is **required** to read this summer. In addition to the required reading, your child has the option to also participate in the Summer Literacy Program, in which they can read extra and/or write during the summer.

The Summer Literacy Program is voluntary, but we want to emphasize that your child will benefit from reading and writing this summer. It is important that your child read books that challenge their reading skills, and a few that are easily enjoyed by him/her. Your child's reading skills will be improved by reading books that are not too easy for him/her; on another hand, easier books help build confidence in reading and will hopefully inspire a love of reading to grow. We encourage reading books at the appropriate reading level.

Students are encouraged to include their Bible reading in their lists. Along with their Bible reading we want to encourage our students to read *The Jesus Storybook Bible* by Sally Lloyd-Jones. If students read this book they should list it on their Bible Reading list. They should include the number of pages they read.

Participating readers will be rewarded with a special outing in the fall! To be considered for an award, students must keep a list of books they read, including the title, author, and number of pages for each book. At the end of the summer, help your child total the number of books read and the number of pages read and sign the book list for your child. **BE SURE TO MAKE A COPY OF THE BOOKS READ FOR YOUR RECORDS**.

Summer reading and writing can be very enjoyable and is important for your child's development. We hope to see long book lists and writings in the fall!
